*The Heidelberg Catechism Q&A #94-96*

Q94: What does the Lord require in the first commandment?

**A94: That I, not wanting to endanger my very salvation, avoid and shun all idolatry, magic, superstitious rites, and prayer to saints or to other creatures. That I sincerely acknowledge the only true God, trust Him alone, look to Him for every good thing humbly and patiently, love Him, fear Him, and honor Him with all my heart. In short, that I give up anything rather than go against His will in any way.**

Q95: What is idolatry?

**A95: Idolatry is having or inventing something in which one trusts in place of or along side of the only true God, who has revealed Himself in His Word.**

Q96: What is God's will for us in the second commandment?

**A96: That we in no way make any image of God nor worship Him in any other way than He has commanded in His Word.**
