The Westminster Larger Catechism, Q&A #9, 11

Q9: How many persons are there in the Godhead?

A9: There are three persons in the Godhead: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit; and these three are one true, eternal God, the same in substance, equal in power and glory; although distinguished by their personal properties.

Q11: How does it appear that the Son and the Holy Spirit are equal with the Father?

A11: The Scriptures show that the Son and the Holy Spirit are God equal with the Father, ascribing unto them such names, attributes, works, and worship, as are proper to God only.
